These outstanding high school seniors will all receive certificates of achievement, and some will get additional honors and a chance to win cash awards of up to \$1,000.

**FOUR FIELDS**  
Awards are presented each year for outstanding scholarship, leadership and

promise of future success and service to society. Covering virtually all high school subjects, they are divided into four broad fields: vocational arts, liberal arts, fine arts, and science and mathematics.

Cash awards to students in Southern California this year will total \$35,400. More than 2700 students will receive certificates, and almost 1,000 of them will get engraved trophies. The 264 cash award winners will take home checks for from \$25 to \$1,000.

**TOP WINNERS**  
Top winners from the local high schools will go to the zone competitions in April, where area-wide winners will be determined by a judging panel of community leaders who listen to the students in group discussions of subjects related to their studies. The first-place winners will then go on to the finals in May, where they will receive at least \$150 and may win one of the top \$1,000 awards.

The Bank of America Achievement Awards program is statewide, with identical awards presented in seven geographical divisions. Total cash awards for the entire state this year will be \$79,600—a new high.

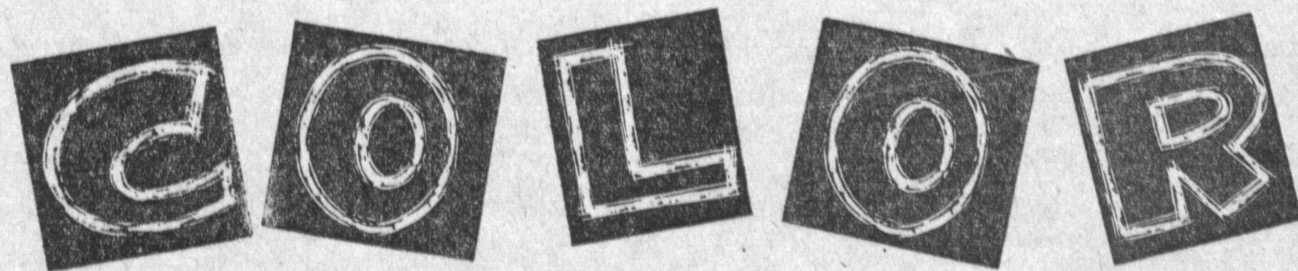

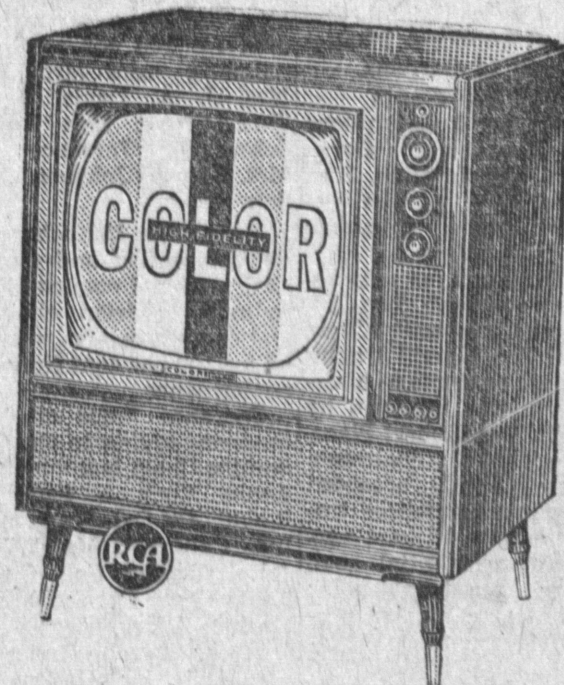
