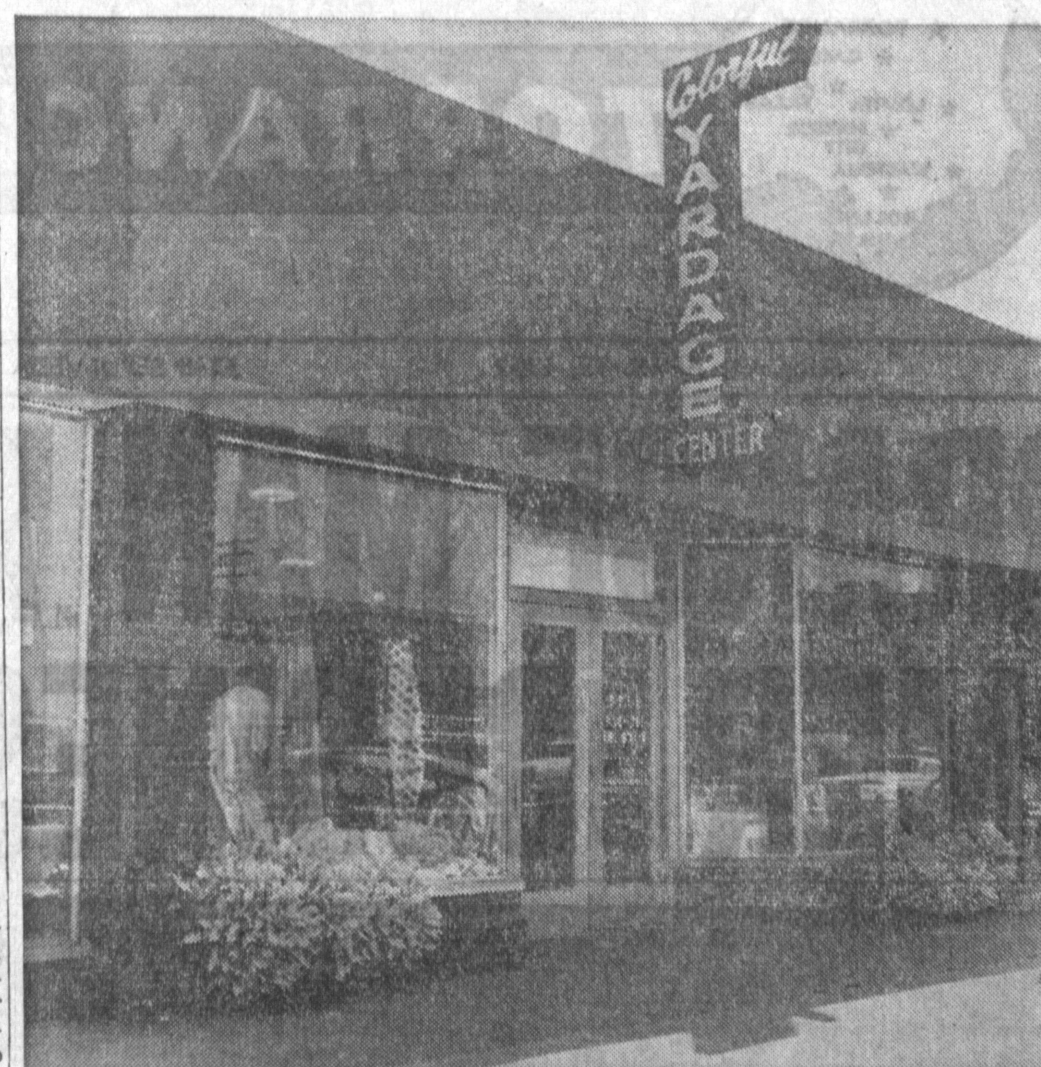

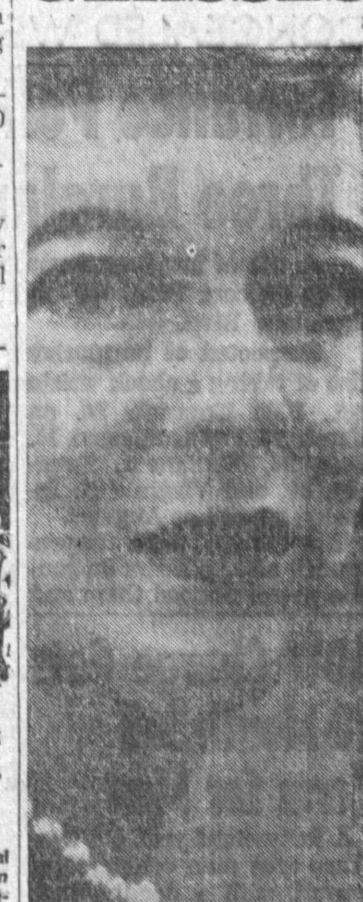
At noon, following the morning events there will be a group picture taken on the steps of the Banning Manor in the park.
