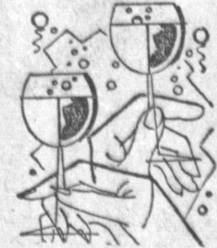

'Burn a Light' Program Tends to Cut Losses from Burglaries

"Burglaries cost the people of this nation millions of dollars annually," Sheriff Peter Pitchess said today, in urging Los Angeles County citizens to pay special attention to the problem during National Burglary Prevention Week, through May 5.

"Burglary losses in the area served by the Sheriff's Department exceeded \$2,800,000 last year," Pitchess stated. "This averages

out to approximately \$153 per person."

"Burglars are 'choosy,'" the Sheriff pointed out. "They look over neighborhoods, and when they find homes with untrimmed grass, or papers cluttering the doorsill, or the garage is empty and unlocked, they assume no one is home. Such a place becomes a likely target for burglars."

There is no such thing as a burglar-proof home, but there are certain things that can be done to minimize the danger. Among the most important precautions:

1. Keep a light burning at night. The Sheriff's Department "Burn a Light" campaign has clearly shown that a lighted home discourages burglars from entering.
2. Keep local law enforcement agencies informed when you are going to be gone for a number of days or weeks.
3. Arrange with neighbors
