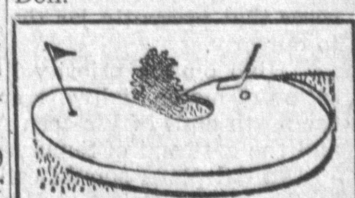
### Reading for "Seven-Year Itch" Called
