Airport Board Approves Budget of \$15 Million

The budget provides for \$2,927,330 for principal and operating and maintenance interest on bonds for expansion and improvement of both Los Angeles International and Van Nuys Airports, and sets aside a reserve of \$4,033,621 for future bond redemption and interest payments on the 1956 airport bonds.

Anticipated receipts of \$8,-953,668 for the 1962-63 fiscal year represent an increase of \$1,180,071 over the previous year, and include \$5,276,237 from aviation revenues; \$3,600,742 from concession revenues; \$35,365 from sales and services; and \$41,324 from other sources.


