

Torrance Minister Attends Convention

The Rev. William Schatz of Torrance was among United Church of Christ teen-agers at their national meeting at West Lafayette, Ind., who rejected the traditional patterns of youth work in most Protestant denominations by abandoning the separate youth organizations in the church.

Two hundred and twenty-five youth delegates and their 50 adult advisors, meeting on the Purdue University campus, unanimously voted to discontinue the segregated youth groups in favor of a plan to integrate the teen-agers into the total life of the church.

The delegates represented the Pilgrim Fellowship of the Congregational Christian

church and the Youth Fellowship of the Evangelical and Reformed Church. The United Church of Christ was formed in 1957 by a union of these two denominations. The youth of the two uniting bodies, while never formally merging, have been working together to evolve the plan voted this week.

NO PROGRAM
No detailed program for accomplishing the integration of the youthful church members was laid down. Rather the assembly concentrated at this time on setting down the basic philosophy of youth work.

The plan, as voted, summarized the central objective: "to make the whole church sensitive to the special needs and concerns of high school young people as well as to make the young people sensitive to the whole church, to other youth, and to the world."

NEW SYSTEM
Under the new system, the traditional national organizational conference of young people will be replaced by an annual Youth Forum in which youngsters from throughout the nation will make a detailed study of a particular problem or social issue.

The first such Forum will be held in 1963, concentrating on the problems of race relations. The place has not yet been determined.
