**College Holds
61 Technical
Night Classes**

A class in the basic principles of data processing will be offered in the Evening Division during the Fall Semester at Harbor College. It was announced today by Mr. Cammen Marinella, chair-man of the Business Division.

The course, which meets from 6:30 to 9:30 on Friday evenings starting the week of Sept. 17, will investigate basic data processing equipment and application. It will feature discussions of automated record keeping, basic computer concepts, and the application of computers to management problems. The course will include visits to data processing installations.

The instructor of the new course, Mr. Frank Fishbaugh, holds a Bachelor's degree from the University of Southern California and has had many years of experience with industry in the field of data processing.

He is presently employed as an operational auditor specializing in data processing control with Space and Information Systems Division of North American Aviation. Mr. Fishbaugh is a member of the Systems and Procedures Association, The National Association of Accountants, and the Institute of Internal Auditors.

Applications for admission to the Fall Semester are being accepted now at the Admissions Office of the college. All persons planning to attend the Fall Semester at the college must apply before Sept. 7.

"More than five thousand electronic computers are in operation today," explained Mr. Marinella, "and our forecasters tell us that five years from now there will be ten to fifteen thousand at work in the United States alone. It behooves everyone in the field of business to inform himself of the impact and application of data processing equipment."

**Hospitalization
Speeded Up**

Hospitalized veterans with dependents will get faster service in receiving pension payments as a result of a new law enacted by the 87th Congress, Mort Webster, Manager of VA's Southern California Regional Office, announced recently.

The law previously specified that when these veterans were in VA hospitals more than two months, their pension payments would be reduced to \$30 a month, with the balance sent to their family in a separate check. This often resulted in delayed payments.

Under the new law, the veteran with dependents will continue to receive the full amount of his pension while in a VA hospital.

The \$30 pension limitation still applies to hospitalized veterans with no dependents.

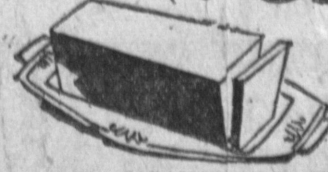
