As an Air Force officer, he headed the group that produced the RB-47 electronic reconnaissance aircraft. It was due to his efforts while chief of ECM for the Strategic Air Command, and later while directing ECM development and procurement at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, that ECM gear was installed on all B-52 and B-47 aircraft. He is a veteran of more than 4,000 hours flying aircraft ranging from the B-18 to the B-52.

WORKED ON B-70

While at North American Aviation, he directed the electronic sub-systems project on the B-70 Valkyrie. Immediately prior to joining the Space and Information with the Utah Division of Systems Division, he was Sperry Rand where he managed the U.S. Army's Sergeant Missile Program.


