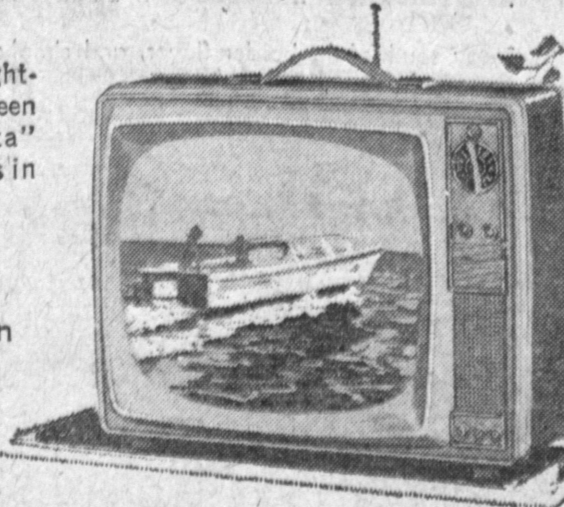

constructed in 1964 by General Phlanas Banning, the harbor community's founder.

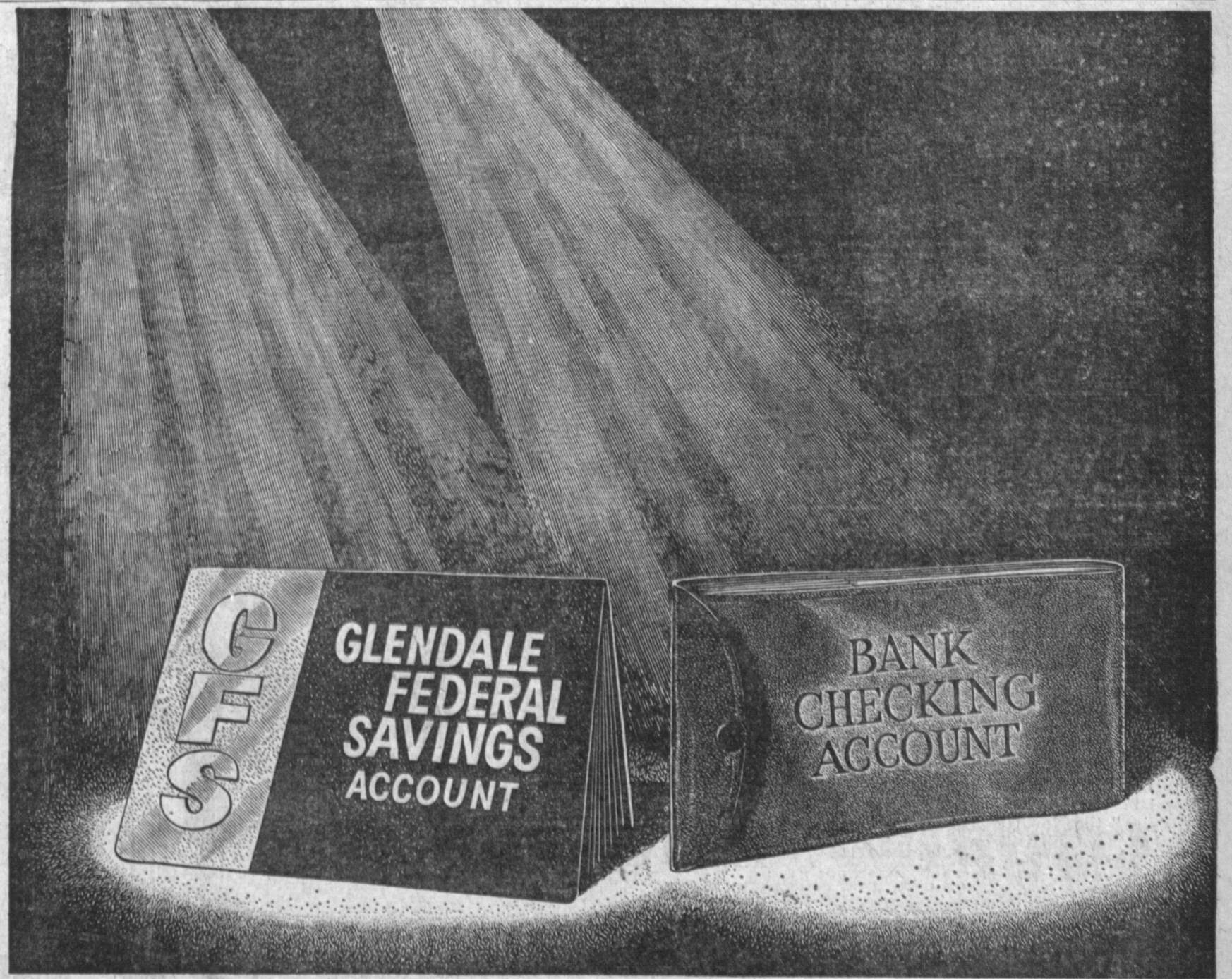
General Banning was a pioneer Southern California
