

## Notes for Family Readiness in Defense Booklet

**EDITOR'S NOTE:** The following are excerpts from a civilian defense pamphlet issued recently by the City of Torrance. A message from Mayor Albert Isen and City Manager Wade Peebles was published last Wednesday. Today's column lists measures to be taken to make families defense-ready.)

**Assembling the Family Group** — In the event of a disaster or threatened disaster we believe the best procedure is to assemble the family at home or in a predetermined place, if at all practicable. If movement to another safer area is required later, due to Torrance becoming unsafe, you will be so advised. If unable to assemble the family prior to a disaster, establish a rendezvous where you can gather when conditions permit.

**Mass Evacuation** prior to an attack is not recommended unless there is reasonable assurance that you can reach your destination and that conditions there are better than in Torrance.

**Dispersal** from congested areas to the suburbs is highly desirable. If time and traffic permits, a limited movement to the outskirts or in a westerly or south-westerly direction may be desirable.

**Medical Assistance** — Through the wholehearted cooperation of the medical and para-medical professions, a complete and comprehensive Medical Plan for use during disasters has been prepared. Emergency Aid Stations throughout the City will be staffed and marked. The staffs of hospitals will be augmented and additional medical supplies have been obtained and stored ready for instant use. Survival in the event of

an attack for those outside the blast area, will depend to a very large extent on the measures taken by the individual now. Your Civil Defense will, through its trained personnel, such as Radiological Defense, Public Safety, and Supply, keep you informed provide warning of Fallout dangers, recommend areas safe against radiation, and furnish emergency assistance, both medical and food.

By individual action, that is, preparing your home for use as a refuge during disaster, and by preparing for your family needs, you can help yourself, your family, and your community.

May I suggest that you ask yourself if you have an adequate Home Preparedness Program. If not, obtain and read the brochures available from your Civil Defense Office and attend one of the Home Preparedness classes conducted by Adult Education. Check your food supply and endeavor to keep at least two weeks supply of basic food on hand. Keep a First Aid Kit ready for use.
