teaspoon chopped parsley. and 1 tablespoon grated le-

mon rind. Parmesan Butter: Add 1 teaspoon parmesan cheese, 2 teaspoon oreano and a few drops of garlic juice.

Add to the meal your choice of already mentioned meats, spread, or fillings. Select a salad or vegetable and finish off with garnishes and anchovies or smoked fillet of herring.

For a light Sunday evening supper, spread bread with butter and make sandwiches ahead. These may be stored all day if carefully made and refrigerated. Simply cover with moisture proof wrapping, not a damp cloth, for best keeping. This leaves you free to relax and enjoy a late-winter afternoon with the family.

Try serving a sandwich meal soon. Ye're sure your family and friends will request it often.

### Reminder to Employers: Tax Form Due in Feb.

Torrance area employers are reminded by Alan Cranston, state controller, and chabiman of the Franchise Tax Board, that they must file information returns with the tax board on, or before, Feb. 28.

The information return (Form 599) must be filed for each unmarried employee who was paid more than \$1500 and for each one who was married and paid \$3000 or more during the calendar year 1962.

Forms 599 must be accompanied by a summary Form 596 and filed with the Franchise Tax Board by Thursday, Feb. 28.
