



Gillespie will be responsible for the engineering, manufacturing, and quality control departments, and will also supervise industrial relations


Gillespie joined the division in September, 1955, as director of industrial relations a position he previous-ly had held with Mission Appliance Corp. He assumed additional duties in 1958.
