The recital will include two Bach selections, Prelude and Fugue in F minor, and Prelude and Fugue in G Major; Three movements from Beethoven's Sonata in D minor, Opus, No. 2; a selection by Chopin, Ballade in G minor, Opus 23; and Estampes by Debussy.

Although he chose to major in Philosophy at Carleton, Mullen has been studying piano since he was eight years old, and has played in numerous recitals at the College.

Active in campus events, he served during his junior year as co-chairman of the College's Junior Carnival committee and also a co-chairman of the publicity

committee for Parents Day. As a freshman he was a member of the cast of the student-produced musical, Guys and Dolls.

Mullen is a graduate of Torrance High School and came to Carleton as a William Carleton scholar, an honorary scholastic award offered to students who show particular "promise of achievement."

Torrance Symphony to Stage Il Trovatore Next Sunday

Il Trovatore, one of the most popular operas, has been selected by Conductor Elyse Aehle as the annual opera production of the Civic Symphony of Torrance this year.

The opera will be staged at Redondo High School Auditorium, Sunday, March 3, at 2:30 p.m.

Heading the cast will be Anne Eagle Machamer, singing Lenora. She is touring with the Pacific West Opera Co., but will return in time to rehearse with the symphony and cast.

Mrs. Machamer has sung Mimi in La Boheme. She sang Madame Butterfly throughout 1962. In 1961,

she sang under the auspices of the San Francisco Opera Company.

Mrs. Machamer has appeared several times in the Hollywood Bowl and also has appeared with several symphonies, including the San Francisco Symphony Orchestra.

Mrs. Machamer is execu-

tive director of the Opera Guild of Southern California, and is active in the Guild Opera Co.

Her husband, Robert Machamer, is general manager of the Los Angeles Opera Co., and handles public relations for Hollywood Bowl. Other prominent soloists to appear in Il Trovatore are Wanda Karos as Azucena; Frederic Gates as the troubador; Enrica Porta as Count di Luna; Lyle Heck as Ferrando, and Evelyn Gamble as Inez.
