

Canned Barbecue Beans Go Well with Pork Chops

Canned barbecue beans can turn a pork chop dish into a meal extraordinary. Three kinds of beans combined in a spicy tomato sauce blend their appealing taste and aroma with colorful crisp apples and succulent pork chops.

Here is a main dish to captivate the entire family. A tossed green salad with your favorite dressing and pumpkin pie — there's a meal to make your family think you're the "greatest."

Canned barbecue beans, come in handy one pound cans, perfect to serve a family of four. Try this Fire-

side Skillet this week.
FIRESIDE SKILLET
4 pork chops (about 1 pound)
1 can (1 pound) barbecue beans
4 slices apple
1 tablespoon brown sugar
Dash ground cinnamon
Dash ground clove
In skillet brown pork chops on both sides. Pour barbecue beans into shallow baking dish; top with pork chops. Place a slice of apple on each chop; sprinkle with sugar and spices. Bake in moderate oven (375 deg. F.) about 45 minutes, or until meat is tender. Makes four servings.

WALNUT SUNDAE TORTE

Bake at 350 deg. for 25 to 30 minutes. Serves 15.

Sift together...
3 cups sifted flour
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon soda
Cream...
3/4 cup butter. Gradually add
2 cups firmly packed brown sugar, creaming well.
Add... 2 unbeaten eggs: beat well.
Combine...
1 1/4 cups milk and
1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla. Add alternately with dry ingredients to creamed mixture. Blend well after each addition.
Stir in... 4 1/2 cups (1 lb.) walnuts, chopped. Turn into 15x10x1-inch jelly roll pan or two 9x9-inch pans, well greased and lightly floured on the bottom.
Bake... at 350 deg. for 25 to 30 minutes.
Serve... warm or cold with whipped cream or ice cream and butterscotch sauce.

BUTTERSCOTCH SAUCE
Melt 1 1/2 cups butterscotch morsels with 1 cup corn syrup, 1/3 cup light cream or half and half and 1/4 cup butter in a saucepan over medium heat. Stir until sauce is smooth and hot. Remove from heat and add 1 teaspoon Burnett's Pure Vanilla. Serve warm or cold. If sauce gets too thick, heat water.

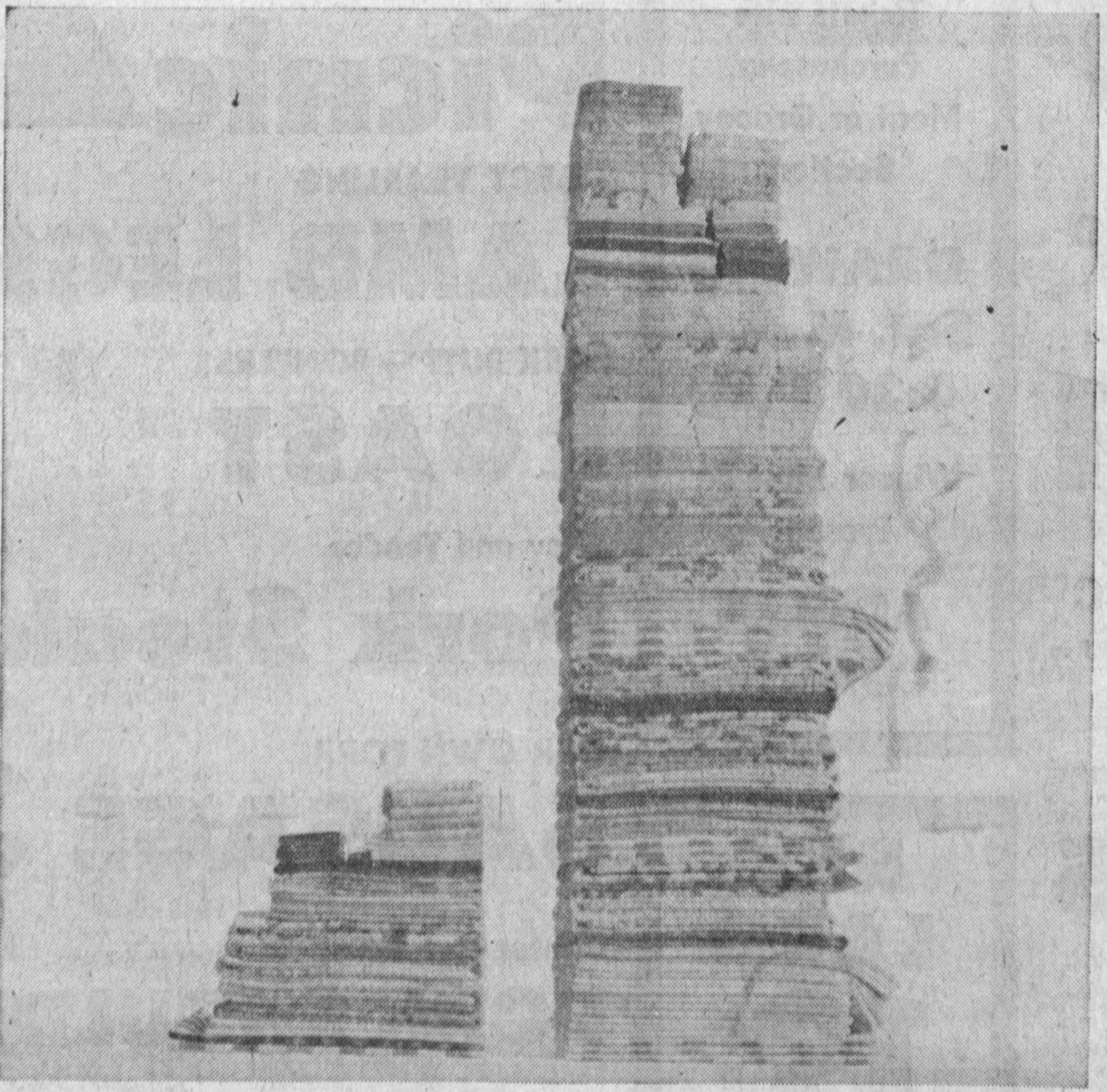
Mike Kelley will provide piano accompaniment during the singing of Irish ballads, according to H. Weaver, Sr., publicity chairman.
