Roasting turkey in aluminum foil is a rather newand much used-method of cooking poultry. Frozen turkeys should be thawed, stuffed and trussed as usual before roasting.

In order to wrap the turkey, a wide piece of aluminum foil is needed (light, medium, or heavy foil may be used). Two pieces of foil may be used, to make one wide piece: lav them together and fold "drugstore" fash-

Lay the turkey on its back in the middle of the foil. Place a small piece of foil over ends of the legs to prevent puncturing the outside of the foil wrap.

Bring the foil from one side up and over the breast of turkey and from the other side lay the foil over the first piece. (Overlay should be at least three inches). Smooth foil over the turkey passing close to the body.

Fold foil from underneath turkey up and over top of bird. The end folds should be three inches or more above the bottom of the pan to prevent drippings from running over top.

Place the wrapped turkey on its back on a rack in a shallow roasting pan. Roast at temperatures and for time given below. (Weight of turkey before stuffing).
