To try to answer, a drag strip is a straight and very level road about 80 feet wide and a mile long.

It is never used if wet or slippery. The drag race itself is only a quarter of a mile and is timed for speed and elasped time from start to finish.

The cars and dragsters that race on a strip must meet very strict qualifications set up by drag strip officials and police departments. A dragster must be weighed to make sure that it is in proper balance and to make sure there is no chance of it flipping over. The steering, brakes, roll

bar, and seat belts are all checked. The driver also has to meet certain qualifications and must wear a crash helmet. The dragster is given a classification and a number. At all races, there


