Marine Private First Class Russell L. Throop, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ralph B. Throop of 1912 218th St., Torrance, is assigned to duty with the First Battalion, Fifth Marine Regiment of the First Marine Division at Camp Pendleton.

One of three infantry regiments in the First Division, the Fifth Regiment is the most decorated Marine Corps organization. Its members are entitled to wear the "fourragere," a tasseled shoulder loop awarded by France for the Fifth Regiment's heroism in World War I, as part of their uniform.

The unit is engaged in continual training which covers all phases of combat operations, ranging from amphibious exercises on Southern California beaches to cold weather training in the Sierra Nevada mountains. This constant training helps insure the high degree of preparedness vital to the Marine Corps in fulfilling its role as the nation's "Force-tains. This constant training in Readiness."
