

## Harbor College Graduation Slated for Area Residents

Harbor College will grant Associate in Arts degrees to 122 candidates at the annual graduation exercises at 6 p.m. Thursday evening, June 20.

The public is invited to attend the exercise which will be held outside in the college quadrangle. A reception in the campus center will follow the program.

Dr. Frederick P. Waelner, professor, emeritus from UCLA, will be the principal speaker. Theme of his talk to the graduates will be "Make Every Stepping Stone a Stepping Stone."

Board member J. C. Chambers will represent the Los Angeles City Board of Education at the program.

Other participants in the program will be Rev. Bert W. Bruffet of the First Christian Church, Wilmington; Robert Dunn, faculty association president; Jean R. Marton, scholarship adviser; and Harbor College president, Wendell C. Black.

Conferring the degrees will be Laurel B. Baker, chairman of the Division of Construction and Art Technology, who is retiring this semester.

Musical selections will be performed by the college choir and band under the direction of Robert Billings and Robin DeVour. Pat Valdez will sing a soprano solo.

"There Is a Balm in Gilead," and the band will play "Pines of the Apian Way," by Respighi.

Associate in Arts degree indicates that the candidates have successfully completed their two-year programs at Harbor College and are prepared either to begin vocational careers or to continue studies at other colleges and universities.

On the morning of graduation the traditional sophomore breakfast will be served in the school cafeteria. Ron Skyers, former student body president, will speak at the breakfast.

## Frogmen of South Bay, Unite And Become Instructors!

A special training program which will certify youth leaders and physical education teachers of southwest, South Bay and Bay communities to teach Junior Frogmen's programs at public schools took place at Pier Aquatics, 5576 Centinela Blvd., Los Angeles.

The course is one of six Junior Frogmen Instructor's Schools scheduled throughout the country during June and July, which will be conducted by D. P. "Pete" Manos, aquatics specialist for the County of Los Angeles Department of Parks and Recreation.

The pool session, which includes instruction in pro-

gram organization, equipment, diving first aid, marine hazards, oceanography, basic physics and physiology and special underwater activities, will be followed by an ocean checkout and written examination.

Junior Frogmen programs are conducted at all county operated pools during the summer months under the supervision of certified instructors. Professional and volunteer recreation leaders, private and public swimming instructors and physical education teachers who successfully complete the course will receive Los Angeles County Certified Underwater Instructor's cards.

Applications and registration fee payments should be mailed to the Junior Frogmen Instructor's School, County Parks and Recreation, 155 W. Washington Blvd., Los Angeles. The \$5 registration fee includes the Junior Frogmen Manual, a certificate, card, patch, and additional printed materials related to underwater diving.

Fins, mask, snorkel and trunks are required for the course.

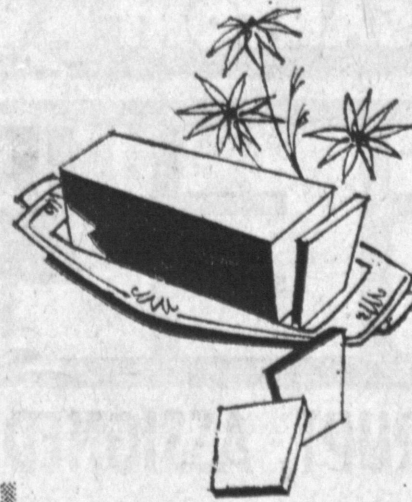
