TEACHERS DON'T USE BOOKS—THEY WRITE 'EM

not only use libraries—they fill them.

Two books by Harbor College instructors have been printed within the last month.

Receiving congratulations from students and fellow instructors were Nicholas Zorotovich, chairman of the social science division, Dwight L. Garner, chairman of the humanities division, and Ralph L. Beckett, English instructor.

Zorotovich has just had his travel book "Wish You Were Here" published by Exposition Press of New York, while Garner and Beckett collaborated on a textbook, "Writing College English," which has been published by Howard Chandler Publishing Company of San Francisco.

School in San Pedro and taught at San Pedro Harbor before joining the Harbor faculty, based his book on the experiences he and his wife, Betty, had during a 10-month sabbatical leave in Europe.

For a good part of the year the Zorotovichs followed the warm weather through Europe. Starting in Italy they traveled through Yugoslavia (where they have relatives) Austria, Switzerland, Germany, Denmark, Sweden, Norway, British Isles, France and Spain.

'Exhilarating' Wife
Although the book is primarily a light, humorous travel book, Zorotovich comments tellingly on the political and economic situations he encountered. Much of the human interest in the

Harbor college instructors book is supplied by experiences of his wife, Betty.

"Traveling with a wife like Betty is an exhilarating experience," Zorotovich remarked. "No one is a stranger to Betty for very long. She has the wonderful knack of starting conversations with total strangers and ending up being friends."

The text, "Writing College English" represents two full years of work by the two authors. It grew out of an informal faculty discussion of what was essential in the English program.

The book was designed for basic and remedial college English courses and is based on the most recent researches in the field of Zorotovich, who went to

English and linguistics.

GUIDING PRINCIPAL

Becket and Garner state their guiding principal in the preface: "Breaking down sentences into clauses and phrases does not make the student a better writer, but repeated, guided practices in writing sentences can definitely improve his ability to write sentences which are clear, complete, correct and interesting."

The text also takes into consideration the differences in usage at various socio-economic levels in American society. The writers state that good usage is that which is appropriate in the level to which the writer belongs.

Garner has been at Harbor College since its founding in 1949. Before that he taught at Banning High School in Wilmington.

Beckett is taking a sabbatical leave from Harbor to study for a doctorate in speech pathology at USC on a fellowship from the department of vocational rehabilitation.

Local Utilities Gain Approval of American Gas Assn.

Southern California and Southern Counties gas companies are among the 14 utilities in the nation who have been honored for their work in helping maintain the high quality and dependability of gas appliances.

The two local companies, who distribute natural gas throughout most of Southern California, recently were presented with certificates by the American Gas Assn. for participation in the national appliance field observation program.

According to G. M. Babbe, division manager for Southern California Gas Co., the AGA's field observation program is a continuing campaign designed to gather data that enables manufacturers to constantly refine their products to make them even more superior.

The more than 100 utilities taking part in the program regularly relay information obtained by field personnel to the AGA Laboratories in Cleveland, where it is passed along to manufacturers.

"This continuous cooperative effort on the part of utilities and manufacturers to improve their products is one of the reasons for the overwhelming popularity of gas appliances in Balanced Power homes here.

Many refinements in gas appliances have been brought about by the national program in recent years, Babbe pointed out. Results of the program can be seen in the ever-increasing sales of gas appliances, both locally and nationally, he said.

The national appliance field observation program is an outgrowth of a system originated shortly after the close of World War II by the local gas companies. It became a national effort during the mid-1950's.
