

## Patriotic Theme Keynotes Cake Decorating Contest

Joy Joeger of Torrance submitted a decorated Betsy Ross-First Flag Cake as first entry in a stars and stripes cake decorating contest being conducted on the Fourth of July at Malaga Cove School, Palos Verdes Estates.

Entries are still being accepted in the contest.

Sponsored by the United Peninsula Republican Clubs as a part of a non-patriotic observance, the contest originated with Mrs. Cloyd Maslet and Mrs. Howard Altermatt of The Girls Floral Shop in Redondo Beach.

Judges selected to choose the prize winning cake are Lee Edwin, home economist from the Southern California Edison Company in Redondo Beach, Mrs. Peggy Cooper, social chairman of the Women's Division of the United Republican Clubs of the Peninsula, and Mayor William Czulegar, Mayor of Redondo Beach.

Regulations governing the contests are:

1. Cakes must be patriotically designed.
  2. No bakery cakes will be accepted.
  3. Only one entry permitted per person.
  4. Open to ALL residents of the South Bay — male or female — regardless of age.
  5. Cakes must be registered by telephone on or before Wednesday, July 3. Telephone exchange to use for registration is FR 5-5085.
  6. Cakes must be delivered to Malaga Cove School by 10 a.m. tomorrow morning.
  7. No cakes are returnable — They will be used as prizes for a donation drawing at the Independence Day celebration.
- First prize offered for the winner will be either a \$25 cash deposit in a savings account at Pacific State Bank,

Palos Verdes Peninsula Center, Hawthorne Blvd., Rolling Hills, or one share of Pacific State Bank Stock. The prize is a donation from the Pacific State Bank in the Peninsula Center.

Second prize will be an authentic reproduction of the Declaration of Independence framed specifically for the occasion by Arnold White Interiors, Plush Horse Inn, Redondo Beach. The document is valued at \$20.

Third prize will be either a fresh or artificial floral arrangement designed for the decor of the winner's home by The Girls Floral Shop, Sea Breeze Plaza, 1926 South Pacific Coast Highway, Redondo Beach.

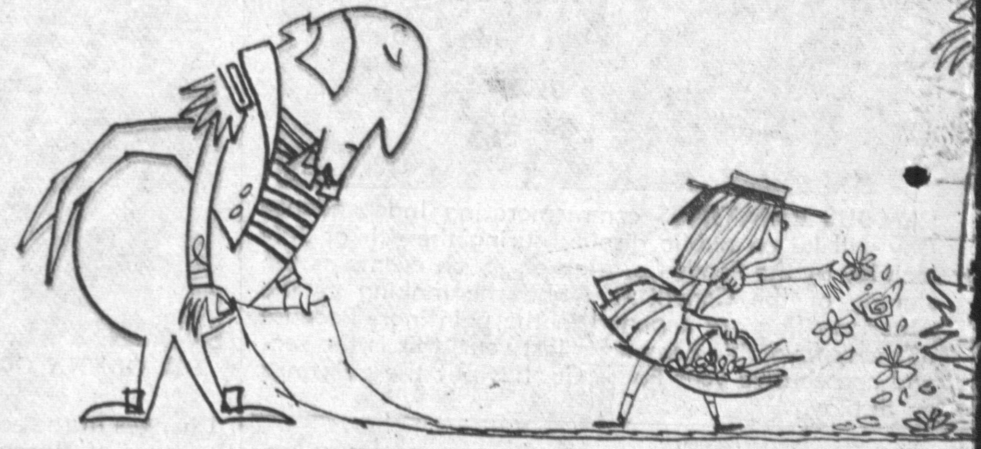

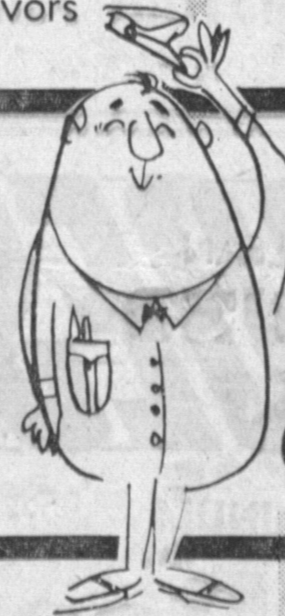
