son's request, a group of Southwood home owners is scheduled to appear before council with a request based on the demonstrations of Saturday, June 29, and the series of continued CORE pickets and sit-ins at the Don Wilson sales office.  
CORE was scheduled to picket again this weekend, possibly to stage further sit-ins on the Wilson property, and has indicated it may attempt to present "qualified" Negro buyers for a home in the Southwood tract.  
**Other Matters**  
Other matters scheduled before the council at its 8 p.m. meeting Tuesday:  
Several plans drafted by city attorney Stanley Remelmeier to prohibit small businesses from operating in apartment houses will be considered.  
Remelmeier also will present a report on damage claims resulting from the February rains. Claims against the city in the amount of \$1,604,563 were made by 42 property owners. The city's property damage insurance amounts to only \$200,000, Remelmeier said, but he pointed out that the settlements bear very little relationship to the claims.  
He indicated in his report that the city should consider increasing its insurance.  
The council will also vote into law its uniform three-step pay plan for city employees, act on proposals to complete sale of additional lands at the city airport, and consider resignations of two city commission members.  
J. C. Babbitt is resigning from the youth welfare commission because of "demands of graduate courses" and William C. Hoag is resigning from the library commission because he is "planning to move out of the community."
