## DOMINGUEZ **CHANNEL BIDS** TO BE OPENED

Bids to construct another link in the 18-mile Dominguez Channel flood control project are scheduled to be opened today.

Estimates place cost of the new unit at about \$3.8 million, according to flood control chief M. E. Salsbury, who will supervise bid openings.

Plans call for improve ment of the channel from Wilmington Avenue to Avalon Boulevard, including more than a mile-and-a-half of reinforced concrete chan-

Dominguez Channel is an outlet for storm drains and will carry flood waters from Inglewood to the harbor when completed. It is being improved in units by the Flood Control District as funds are available.


### \$6,500 PROJECT DUE TO START


