

FUN TRIPS ARE SLATED FOR LOCAL CHILDREN

Anyone for POP? How about Marineland? Catalina? The San Diego Zoo? Field trips to these and other fascinating and enjoyable places are being sponsored this summer by the Torrance recreation department for the benefit of the children of the community.

During a recent week, for example, three trips were taken — to the city of Los Angeles, where Olvera St. and Chinatown were toured and other sights discovered; to Marineland; and to the Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbors, where a harbor cruise provided new appreciation and knowledge of our shopping facilities.

In all, 215 children from 8 parks and playgrounds/enjoyed these trips, which cost an average of \$1 per child, including transportation fare and insurance. All trips are amply supervised by qualified recreation personnel.

Future excursions will include Catalina, the Griffith Park and San Diego Zoos, a beach outing, a Bowling Day, and a trip to Disneyland, among others.

Assemblyman Conrad Due to Address Area GOP Unit

Charles J. Conrad, Republican assemblyman from the 57th district and minority floor leader, will address the South Bay Young Republican Club Thursday at 8 p.m. at Smith Brothers Fish Shanty, 4164 Pacific Coast Hwy. The meeting will be preceded by a social hour.

Conrad is a veteran of 16 years of service in the California Legislature. He has been described in newspaper editorials as a "hard working member of the 'good government' group which brought a refreshing change in the Assembly." He has served on the rules committee, ways and means committee, election and reapportionment committee, and speaker pro tempore of the Assembly.

"Charlie Conrad will be coming to the South Bay directly from the special legislative session in Sacramento," Bus Turner, South Bay YR president, stated today. "What better way do taxpayers in our area have of finding out what really went on in the battle of the state budget than to come to our meeting Thursday evening?" Turner said.

A graduate of the University of Pennsylvania, he served in WW II and has had a career in motion pictures and television in addition to his public service career in Sacramento.

STREET OK'D FOR CROSSING OF RAIL TRACK

The California Public Utilities Commission authorized today a request by the City of El Segundo to construct Douglas Street across the tracks of the Santa Fe and Pacific Electric Railroads at the north end of a mile-square area bounded by El Segundo Boulevard, Sepulveda Boulevard, Rosecrans Avenue and Aviation Boulevard.

A request to extend Douglas Avenue over the Santa Fe tracks at the south end of the area was denied.

The commission's approval of the north grade crossing will permit the area to be developed commercially and will provide an access road for fire-fighting equipment.

At a public hearing on the request, it was stated that development of the southerly area was in the indefinite future, dependent on sale of parcels of land.

The commission, in authorizing the construction, specified that the grade crossings be protected by flashing-light signals, supplemented by automatic crossing gates.

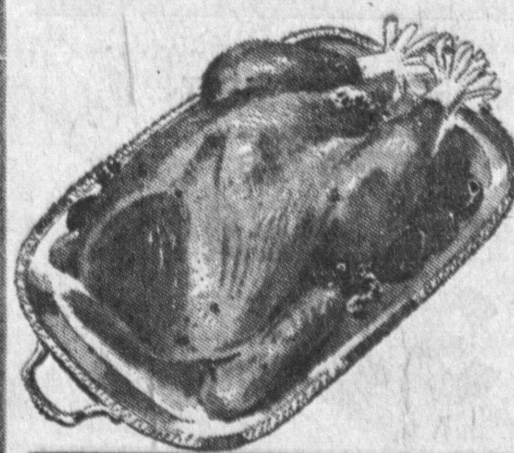

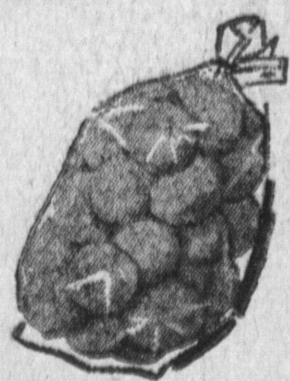
