

CARSON STREET JOBS PUSHED BY COUNTY

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn this week announced that funds have been allocated for two roadway improvement projects in the Carson area.

Work will begin within three weeks on widening to two lanes the north side of 223rd St. just east of Main St.

Also scheduled to begin within 15 days is a similar widening project on Carson St. at Berendo Ave.

"Carson carries a daily average of 21,000 vehicles in this area," Hahn noted.

He pointed out that 223rd St. carries about 6000 vehicles a day east of Main St.

"The completed improvements," he added, "will increase traffic capacity, lower maintenance costs and add to the operational effort of these streets."
