## Schultz Bids for 5th Straight

A first year expert rider, 22-year-old Elliott Schultz of South Gate, will be gunning for his fourth straight (and fifth of the summer season) main event victory when the AMA flat track half-milers swing back into action Friday night at Ascot Park in Gardena. Qualifying starts at 7 p.m., racing at 8:15. Counting trophy dash and heat wins, Schultz has run up an amazing record of nine triumphs in his last nine starts. Racing director J. C. Agajanian points out that Schultz, driving a British Royal Enfield motorcycle, has started the veterans (most of the point leaders ride BSA cycles), by catapulting from 16th in championship point standings last month to fifth. With 763 points, Schultz this Friday night could pass Jack O'Brien (779) and Al Gunter (778) to move into third place if he continues his winning ways. Sammy Tanner, who lost

the main event lead to the main event lead to Schultz last week and finished second, still leads the back with 1200 points while Stu Morley has 998 for second place. Tanner, of Bellflower; Morley of Topanga; O'Brien of Santa Monica; and Gunter of Alhambra, all ride BSAs. Friday night's motorcycle program includes main events for expert, amateur and novice riders plus heat races and the trophy dash for the four fastest qualifiers. **BAILEY WINS TITLE; WILL RACE HERE** Bob Bailey of Torrance, who captured the national 10-mile motorcycle championship race Sunday at Springfield, Ill., will be bidding for new honors in the flat track AMA races. Friday night at Ascot. Bailey, second in TT standings, is rated a growing threat in the flat races.

## Bob Hoyle Seeks to Extend Sprint Car Victory String

Bob Hoyle will go after his sixth 30-lap event win of the year when he meets a 35-car field of star drivers in tonight's 8-event CRA sprint car racing program at Gardena's Ascot Park, 183rd St. at So. Vermont Ave., where racing gets underway at 8:30 p.m., preceded by one lap qualifying runs at 7 p.m. Hoyle, the number one driver in CRA points for 1963, won his fifth main event of the year last week at the wheel of the brand new Kenny Worth, Chevrolet powered special from San Gabriel before the largest Wednesday night crowd of the year.

A threat is one-armed Al-len Heath of Northridge in the powerful 427 cubic inch, T-Bird powered special owned by Vel's Ford of Torrance. Heath led for 13 laps of last week's feature before giving way to Hoyle's challenges. He is looking for his fourth main event triumph of the year. Racing includes a 15-lap semi-main, four 6-lap heat races; and a 3-lap trophy dash. Gates open at 6:30 p.m., when 7,000 general admissions seats go on sale at popular prices. Kids under eight are free with adult.

## STEELE OUT TO REGAIN TOP FORM

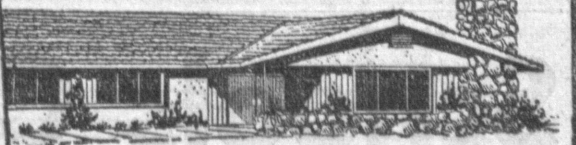

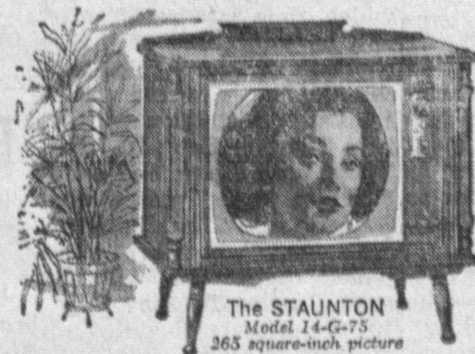
