Water Basin Levels Down

With one notable exception, levels in county water basins are expected to be lower this fall because of last winter's sparse rainfall, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn reported today. Levels forecast to remain about the same are in the Torrance, West Long Beach, and Venice areas. About three feet lower this year will be basins in the vicinity of Inglewood and Hawthorne. Rainfall statistics compiled by the flood control district indicate the 1962-63 water year will be the fourth out of the last five in which amounts have been about half of normal. Importance of the ground water wells to Los Angeles County is pointed up by the fact that over 50 per cent of the county's daily water supply is pumped from these sources, Hahn said. Twenty basins are expected to be lower this fall compared to 1962, when only nine basins were lower. Hahn said the bright spot in the picture is in the Central Basin, where pumping was reduced in October, 1962. The resulting recovery of wells between the spring of 1962 and the spring of 1963 ranged from about 10 to 30 feet. Areas showing the greatest rise were north of Signal Hill and vicinity of Vernon.

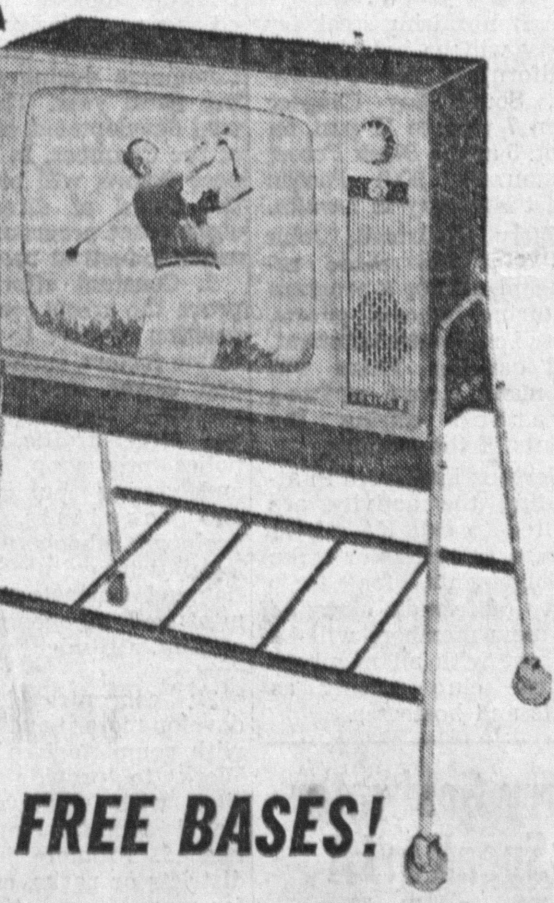

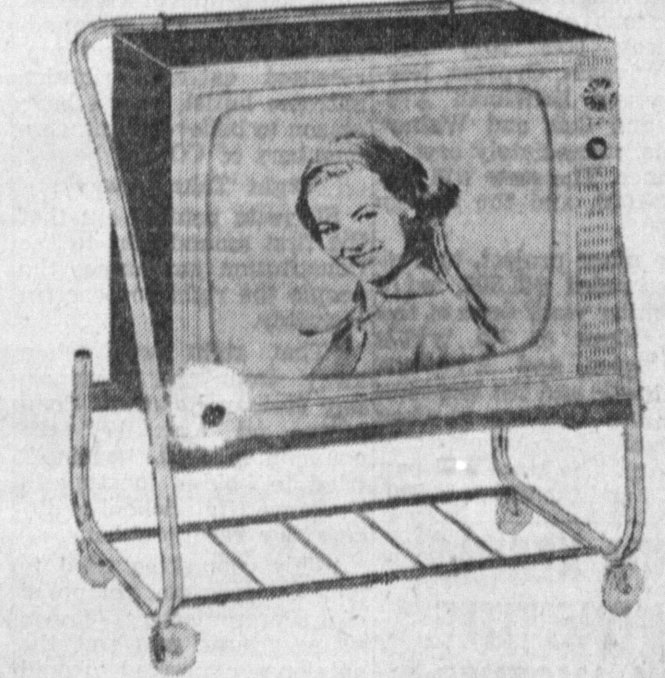
