### SUPERVISORS DEDICATE CARSON BRIDGE

Supervisors Burton W. Chace and Kenneth Hahn joined with local civic and business leaders Wednesday for dedication of the \$500,000 bridge spanning Dominguez Channel at Figueroa Street.

Among public groups attending the program were representatives of Harbor District Chambers of Commerce, including Carson,

Dominguez, and Gardena Chamber groups.

The new structure, recently opened to traffic, was designed by the County Road Department and constructed at a cost of \$498,817 by John L. Meek Construction Co.

"Major phase of the work," Chace said, "included the major bridge span on Figueroa, including an 80-foot roadway and sidewalks."

"In addition, concrete curbs, gutters and street drainage facilities were installed so that the new structure has more than tripled the traffic capacity to 36,000 cars daily," Chace added.
