Dear Sir: The League of Women Voters of Torrance feels that it must add its voice to those who have registered alarm at the attempts to break up the August 17th Forum at Torrance High School.

The following is a statement presented to the Torrance City Council on August 27th by the League: "I am here this evening as a representative of the League of Women Voters of Torrance. Our organization is non-partisan in nature and devoted to the promotion of political responsibility through informed and active participation of citizens in government."

"The League of Women Voters of Torrance would like to express its deep concern over the disruption of a public meeting by a group of hecklers at Torrance High School August 17. The right of peaceful assembly is basic and vital to the preservation of the freedom of us all. Intimidation by words and social pressures can be as devastating as physical force, and thus in effect represents a threat to this right."

We should like to draw attention to the fact that a spokesman for the hecklers at this particular meeting expressed his group's intent of future militancy. We feel that no group should fear holding a peaceful assembly in Torrance, nor should any individual fear attending any meeting of his choice.

We respectfully suggest that the Council, as elected representatives of all of the people of Torrance, resolve that attempts to disrupt public meetings by rudeness, heckling and verbal intimidation threatens the right of peaceful assembly and have no place in this city." High School Diploma At Banning Adult School

With the increasing importance and necessity of the high school diploma being emphasized more and more, the Phineas Banning

Adult School continues to give priority to the academic program leading to the diploma without detracting from the strong vocational program, long a part of the school offerings, as the adult school attempts to meet the educational needs of the community.

Many high school dropouts become high school "drop sacks" as young adults discover that dropping out of school before graduation is not as rewarding and satisfying as they thought it would be. On discovering that most employers prefer workers who have the high school diploma, they are glad to know that they can continue where they left off by enrolling in classes at the Banning Adult School, 1500 Avalon Blvd., in Wilmington.

There is no tuition charge for students working for the high school diploma under the advisement and direction of counselors. Counselors are on duty each school day evening to assist students in selection of courses that are required for graduation. Vocational and educational counseling is also available to all students enrolled in the adults school. Older adults who return to take up their high school education are surprised and pleased to find many others their age and older who have decided to get the high school diploma. They learn, as many others have learned, that "It is never too late to begin at Banning."
