

### Art and Artist Lecture Series Meets this Fall

Art and artists will set the stage for the coming University of California Extension lecture - demonstration series "Value of the Arts," to be held in Torrance this fall.

Mary Holmes, Lecturer in Art at UCLA will introduce the series Oct. 8, Oct. 15 she will be followed by Lester Longman, professor of art, speaking on the subject "Painting — Man's First Medium of Expression." Other subjects to be explored will include architecture, dance, drama, sculpture, music, poetry and design. Oct. 22 Maximilian E. No-

vak, professor of English at UCLA will speak on "Fiction — What Literature Means to Man."

The class will meet for twelve Tuesdays from 7:30 through 9:45 p.m. in room 228 of North High School, 3620 West 182nd St. It will be in two parts, the first running from Oct. 8 through Nov. 12; the second Nov. 19 through Jan. 7. Enrollment may be for six lectures, Part I or Part II. Single admissions will be available at the door if space permits. ### Royalty Visits Marineland

The king and queen of Afghanistan and an official party from the small nation in southwestern Asia will visit Marineland of the Pacific next Sunday, Sept. 15. They are scheduled to arrive at 11 a.m.

Under the auspices of the U.S. State Department, the royal party has been touring America. The party leaves tomorrow on the first leg of the return journey to Kabul, the nation's capital. The 245,000-square mile nation lies adjacent to Russia, China, India, Pakistan and Persia.

King Mohammed Baher and Queen Homaira will be welcomed to the oceanarium by William F. Monahan, vice president and general manager of Marineland. Included in the group will be Ali Mohammed, court minister and chief of the royal secretariat; Abdullah Malikyar, first deputy prime minister and minister of finance; Dr. Abdul Majid, ambassador of Afghanistan, and Nour Ahmed Etemad, secretary general of foreign affairs. The American party will be headed by John M. Steeves, American ambassador to Afghanistan.


