

Movie Premiere Proceeds to Go to Torrance YMCA

YMCA announced today that all proceeds from the Grand Opening Premier of the newly built Rolling Hills Theatre will go to the local "Y."

Board Chairman Dr. Allen Pyeatt has named Dr. Rollin R. Smith General Chairman of the benefit performance.

The Grand Opening will be held on Tuesday evening, Oct. 1, with outdoor entertainment starting at 7:30. A major studio preview will follow in the new cinema house at 8:30 p.m.

The Sterling Theatre organization will donate entire 1,000 seats to the YMCA's building and Youth Work fund for the first night of operation.

Dr. Smith stated that laymen from the local YMCA carry responsibility to provide the outdoor show and to "pack the house with happy people."

'Office Trailers' To Be Registered

Trailers used for offices or for human occupancy in industrial or commercial enterprises must be registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles beginning Sept. 20.

Tom Bright, director of the department, said the 1963 Legislature included such trailers — often called "office trailers" in the California Vehicle Code definition of a trailer coach. "In this category," Bright said, "they are subject to registration with the department and must bear current license plates."

Many of these "office trailers" were formerly considered commercial type vehicles when the trailers were used on the highways and owners were required to pay commercial vehicle weight fees. Under the new law all such trailers will be registered without payment of weight fees, and as with conventional trailer coaches they will have to be licensed whether or not they are operated on the highways.

Bright cautioned owners to register currently unlicensed trailers before Oct. 19. Penalties are due after that date, he said.
