They are in the Naval Reserve. Dubbed "Pacific Sail," the exercises involved 13 ships, approximately 1,100 members of the Naval Reserve, and some 1,200 active duty personnel, comprising Reserve Destroyer Squadron 27.

Except for a four-day stopover at Pearl Harbor, the Reserve cruise was devoted to anti-submarine warfare training, replenishment-at-sea practice, shipboard drills, and surface firing operations.

During their training recruits receive tests and interviews which determine their future naval assignments. Upon completing the program they are assigned to service schools for technical instruction or to ships or shore stations for on-the-job training.
