

WINTER COMING, CHECK HEATERS, WARNS CHIEF

With the coming of the fall season and cooler weather, many of us will be turning on our furnaces or wall heaters for the first time in many months.

In order to receive the maximum efficiency and smoke and odors from such appliances, these few simple precautions should be taken reports Fire Chief J. J. Benner.

Remove the floor grating or wall panel an area that accumulations of lint and foreign objects are removed from the enclosed heater area.

Before replacing the floor grate or wall panel turn the furnace on and check the burners for adjustment.

If the flame, either on the main burner or pilot light does not appear to be properly adjusted, call the repair service department of your local gas company.

Another appliance which is overlooked by many people is the clothes dryer. Failure to periodically clean the lint trap and the surrounding area causes fires and often ruins clothes, kitchen and appliances. Be sure you take a few minutes to clean the lint trap after each use.
