Most women bake a cake soon after they get their new gas range, so in case you're in the mood, here's a delightful devil's food cake for you.

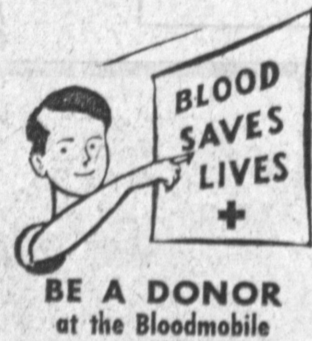
Dexil's Food Cake
1 3/4 cups sifted cake flour
1/2 tsp. salt
1 tsp. soda
1/2 cup shortening
1 1/4 cups sugar
2 eggs
1 cup sour milk or buttermilk

2 sq. baking chocolate
1 tsp. vanilla
Place chocolate in a small saucepan on the automatic top burner set at 150 deg. While the chocolate is melting, sift together flour, salt and soda.

Cream shortening to soften. Add sugar gradually, beating well to obtain a fluffy mixture. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.
Add sifted dry ingredients alternately with sour milk. Blend in vanilla and melted chocolate. Pour batter into two oiled 8 inch pans. Bake in gas oven 350 deg. for 30 to 35 minutes.
Use favorite frosting.

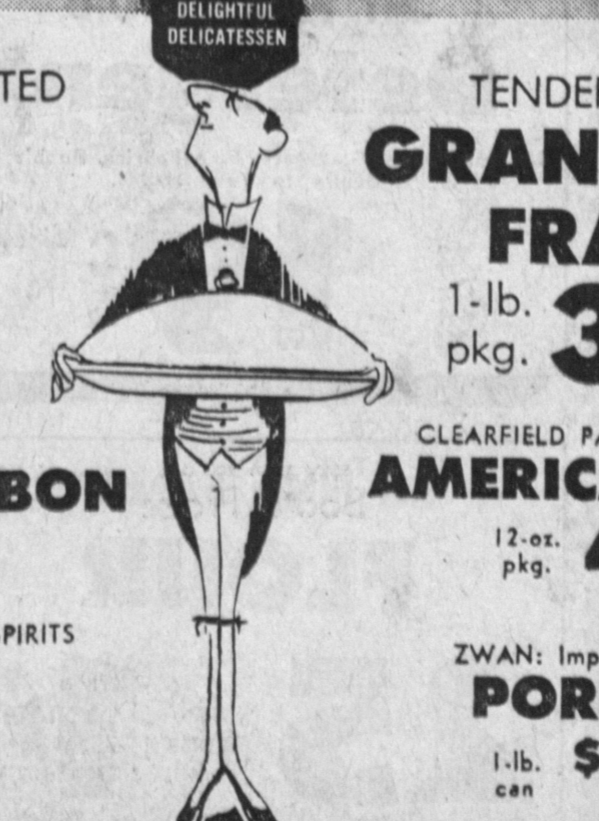
