HARBOR COLLEGE INSTRUCTOR PUBLISHED READING TEXT

Added to the growing list of Harbor College authors this week was the name of John K. Whelan, journalism and English instructor. Whelan is co-author along with Norman Schacter of a reading word book, "Just For Fun." This is the first of three books that the authors have prepared for use in junior high school and high school grades. "Just For Fun" is based on material that junior high school students read every day in the course of their usual activities without considering it as literature or a reading assignment. Some of the material comes from newspaper stories, schedules, box scores and advertisements. Also included are word games, puzzles, vocabulary drills and spelling drills.

"Even the so-called retarded reader reads a great mass of information everyday just to gather facts that interest him, such as the results of an athletic event or the time of a show," says Whelan. "We can devise drills based on these activities that will improve his reading ability greatly." The first of the three work books came from the presses of the Steck Publishing Co. in Austin, Texas this week. The other two will be published before the start of the spring semester.

Whelan and Schacter, who spent more than three years gathering and revising the material, consider the book to be helpful in any program to increase reading skills.

Whelan, who lives at 13 Clipper Road, Portuguese Bend, taught for 12 years at San Pedro High School before moving to Harbor College where he is now starting his third year of teaching journalism and English and advising the school newspaper. Schacter, who is now principal of Richard Byrd Junior High in the San Fernando Valley, taught English and coached basketball at Washington High School in Los Angeles. He is also an official in the National Football League. Other Harbor College instructors who have had books published recently are Nicholas Zorotovich, chairman of the Social Science Division, who wrote a travel book "Wish You Were Here," and Ralph Beckett and Dwight Garner, chairman of the Communications Division, who wrote a textbook, "Writing College English."
