## Poisonous **Snakes Out** In Summer By K. H. Sutherland, M.D. County Health Officer

Poisonous snakes are al-ways observed in certain areas of Los Angeles County at this period of the year. Campers, bikers, and people who live near the hills or in desert areas should be alert to the days of snakehite as

to the danger of snakebite as long as the temperature re-mains in the vicinity of 60 de-grees Fahrenheit and above. The only poisonous snakes that inhabit California belong

to the pit viper family, which includes the sidewinder and the Mojave and Pacific rattle-snakes. The Pacific rattler is the one generally found in the foothills and mountains. whereas the others are native to desert areas.

SNAKEBITE is always a serious medical emergency, but is particularly so in the case of children and elderly people. The situation is ex-tremely critical when chil-dren recieve a large dose of venom, as the ability of the body to withstand the poison body to withstand the poison is in direct proportion to body weight. In the case of el-derly or debilitated persons, the body is simply less able to resist the poison. Generally apeaking, the larger the snake

speaking, the larger the snake the greater the amount of venom injected.

The depth of the bite and the place the poison enters the body influences the victim's physical reaction to it. An injection directly into a blood vessel, for instance, may result in sudden death, while bites on the legs and arms are less dangerous than when the face and head are involved. The danger to the victim is also less when the injection of venom is just under the skin rather than into a muscle.

THERE ARE many opinions expressed in medical journals as to the efficacy of various forms of treatment, but all physicians are agreed that the coner treatment is begun the better it is for the pa-

The amount of activity on the patient's part is related to the rapidity with which to the rapidity with which the poison spreads through-out the body, so the victim should move as little as pos-sible after the bite occurs. As a matter of fact anything that stimulates circulation should

be avoided.

Prompt administration of antivenin is advised, or, in lieu of that, the chilling and immobilization of the affected part for relief of pain until medical aid can be obtained. Whenever possible, it is also recommended that the indivi-dual be hospitalized for further treatment.

OTHER FIRST aid measures have been debated at some length. The procedure generally employed in this area, and which is recommended in the Red Cross First Aid Manual, includes cutting and sucking the wound. This is done in order to remove as much of the poison as is possible before it is

to remove as much of the poi-son as is possible before it is absorbed by the body. A cross-cut incision (about ¼ inch long and 1/8 inch deep) is made through each fang mark and suction start-ed. If no suction apparatus is at hand, mouth suction must be used. This is a relatively safe procedure for the person applying the suction as long as there is no abrasion in the tion be continued for at least 30 minutes to an hour.

If a person is alone when the indicident occurs, this same technique may be used whenever possible. The vic-tim should then walk, not run, for help.

RESIDENTS of snake - in fested areas should keep free of rubbish, lumber piles and the like where snakes may hide. Since snakes feed on rodents, be sure that the pre-

mises are not infested with Whenever snakebite occurs, medical attention should be obtained without delay and first aid measures started as

quickly as possible.
