Enrollment Still Open At School

Immanuel Lutheran School will double its faculty and add a kindergarten when classes resume Sept. 16.

More than ever before, we are now equipped to carry out this function," Hoppe pointed out.

A PHYSICAL education program adopted last year will be continued, he indicated. Hoppe also stressed

that efforts are being made to provide a system of transportation and a hot lunch program.
