BERTRAND M. Harding, acting commissioner of In

Code. It is not permissible, for
example, for to defer withholding of the income tax from the first second or third paychecks in
a month and then withhold a month, and then withoi
the accumulated tax liability of the employe from the fourth pay period. In addition to failing $t$ such a plan could work hard ship on the employe, Mr.
Harding said. The employ Harding said. The employe
who does not carefully budget his income might find the amount of his last paycheck of the month insufficient meet his expenses.

MR. HARDING called attention to Sections 7212 an Code. These provide that any employer required to collect, truthfully account for and pay over these taxes, and who
fails to do so at the time and manner prescribed by the law and regulations may be re quired to deposit such taxe in a special trust account ment, and file monthly re The payments into the spe cial account in such circum stances must be made withi two days of very payday. S vere penalties are provide
by law for failure to make deposits and payments whe the prescribed notice to do ${ }^{30}$ has been issued to the em ployer.
