## **STL Holds** Dedication For Center

A million dollar center produce microscopically small electronic circuits for manned and unmanned spacecraft was dedicated in Lawndale Wednesday by TRW Space Technology Laboratories.

TRW's 15,000 square-foot, company - funded Microelec-tronics Center will turn out special high performance and ultra-reliable electronics comultra-reliable electronics com-ponents for systems and sub-gystems projects such as the L un a r. Excursion Module (LEM) of NASA's Apollo spacecraft and many of the other spacecraft and space communications projects now in progress, all at TRW Space Technology Laboratories.

"We have built the Micro-electronics Center so that we may be better equipped to meet the increasingly strin-gent technical requirements of our customers in the De-partment of Defense and the partment of Defense and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration," said Dr. Ruben F. Mettler, presi-dent of TRW Space Technol-ogy Laboratories.



The tedious job of weeding the lawn and garden need no longer be a major problem, but care must be taken to learn to use the right sub-stance the destroy the weeds or seeds in the right season.

Many weed killers are de-signed to kill the seed in preemergence stages. Others to kill through foliage and still others to kill through roots.

During the past summer many weed seeds have implanted themselves in the



ground. Even though you have taken care to destroy the weed those loose seeds will live to grow a new crop. Ask your nurseryman to recommend a good pre-emer-gence killer for your particu-lar use, making sure that you describe the area in which it is to be used. Keep in mind that other grass seeds and tree roots are apt to be affected by the use of some substances.

In the spring if you see that some of the weeds have survived then turn to a se-lective weed killer before seeds begin to drop into the area again.

The substance 2.4- Dwith 2-4-D-5-T is very effective in taking out some of the un-wanted weeds and grasses. Be sure that you have read the directions on the labels of any weed killer before you use it.


