Finding Teachers Keeps Him Very Busy All Year

ing material? "The two "The two major require-ments of a good teacher are mastery of the field in which he is to teach and the ability to establish positive relationship with both students and adults," he said.

Commenting on predicted increased competition for good teaching jobs, Dr. Mor-ton pointed out that there will be a national increase of 13 per cent in the number of college graduates entering the profession next June. He stated that significant per-centage increases will be found in the number of feachers going into foreign teachers going into foreign language, English, mathematics, and science. In addition he remarked, the fields of men's physical education and social science will continue to be overcrowded. "It has been predicted that the nation will not be able to absorb over one-third of the men's physical education graduates in full phys ed assignments," he said

What does Dr. Morton do when he's not hiring teachers?

In addition to maintaining a teaching and administrative staff of 1,251 persons, the personnel division has a staff of 125 substitutes to contact when teachers are unable to make it to school.
