

# 'Headlines in Flowers' Theme for Rose Parade

"Headlines in Flowers" is the theme for the 1965 Tournament of Roses, Walter R. Hoeflin Jr., president of the Tournament Association, has announced. Each of the 61 floats must be designed and decorated to depict the theme.

This year's theme was selected from more than 7,000 entries submitted by persons throughout the nation. Mrs. Frederick Kirr of Altadena, Calif., submitted the winning theme and will be a guest of honor at the parade and Rose Bowl game.

William Lawson chaired the committee which selected the theme.

AMONG THE titles of early entries are, "First Headline," "Fair and Warmer," "Good News Travels Fast," "A Trip to the Moon," and "Tomorrow's Headline." The floats will depict many momentous happenings as recorded in the bold-faced type of newspapers throughout the history of the world.

Commenting on the theme, Hoeflin said, "As early as 1895, which was the sixth year of the parade, stories were written about the midwinter event for editions in many larger cities. The media is most deserving of the salute that we are giving it with this theme."

NEW ENTRANTS in the parade include Quincy, Ill., the 1964 All-America City winner; Calgary, Canada, and the State of Wyoming, which celebrates its 100th anniversary in 1965.

Torrance will be one of the cities represented in flowers on New Year's Day, along with 21 top bands and 225 of the nation's foremost equestrian units.
