Garden Checklist

1. This is just about your last chance to select a living Christmas tree. Keep it tubbed for the holiday season, then later if you prefer, transplant it. Do not keep indoors too long.

2. Make your first planting of gladiolus as soon as they show up in nurseries. Some are already there, waiting for you to take home and plant.

3. Plant roses and all other deciduous trees and shrubs now.

4. Grapes may be pruned any time now. Be sure you know what you want the vine to do before you start. Ask any nurseryman if you're not sure.

5. Plant the bright florist's Cyclamen in sheltered outdoor gardens or in a light and airy sun porch. They bloom all winter.
