

Vanishing Indian Tribe Gains State Attention

The vanishing Tolowa, an Indian largely ignored in the annals of California history, finally is receiving some attention.

Going directly to the source, the few Tolowa still alive, University of California graduate student Richard Gould has uncovered a rich store of information about the northwestern California tribe.

With the help of Tolowa oldtimers (some in their 90's) Gould, his wife, and six fellow UC anthropology graduate students from Berkeley located and uncovered remnants of two Tolowa villages, one hundreds of years old.

The find was at Pt. St. George, in the rugged north coast area near Crescent City.

A complete flint workshop, fully equipped with a windbreak and worktable along with flints and arrowheads, was found this summer bu-

ried some six feet in the ground.

This represented a section of the oldest village.

"IT WAS undisturbed," Gould reported. "It was in marvelous condition, just as though the Indians had walked away and left it."

Several feet above the workshop the anthropologists found a complete village, abandoned, says Gould, probably sometime in the mid 19th century.

It contained a family house made of redwood, with a blue clay floor and a hearth. It contained artifacts including a lavishly decorated nose plug, symbol of wealth.

CHARCOAL collected at the site is undergoing Carbon-14 analysis at UC's Scripps Institution in La Jolla to obtain a more exact determination of dates.

Gould became interested in the Tolowa, or what remains of the tribe, after reading an obscure monograph written in the 1930's and received a \$3,100 National Science Foundation grant to pursue his research.

Gould surmises that massacres by colonists, seeking control of the good Crescent City harbor, along with white domination of the area, were major factors in the decline of the Tolowa. Disease also took a heavy toll.

Gould's findings, approximately 400 artifacts plus 1,000 samples of bone, soil and food, have been given to the Lowie Museum of Anthropology on the Berkeley campus.
