Road Work Begins in Carson Area

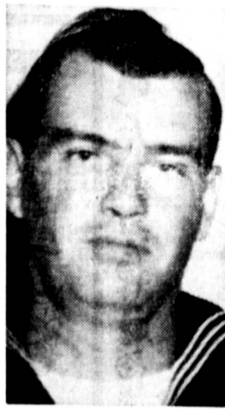
Improvements involving the reconstruction of portions of Avalon Boulevard were started last week, according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.
