Seaside Celebrates 'Self-Support' Day

Seaside Community Church, Ocean Avenue and 230th Street, celebrated "Self-Support Sunday," marking the end of 10 years of aid from the United Church of Christ. Representing the denomination, the Rev. Dr. Howard Stone Anderson, Southern California Conference Minister of the United Church of Christ delivered the message entitled "The Land of Beginning Again."

Seaside was organized Feb. 21, 1954 by the Rev. Richard Miller and held its first meeting in the parsonage at 5342 Sharynne Lane. The present chapel and educational building were completed and dedicated April 17, 1956.

During the past year, under the guidance of the Rev. Francis A. Rath who was installed as minister in 1962, the church has initiated proceedings to realign itself with the merger of the Evangelical and Reformed Church and the Congregational Christian Churches. The church successfully concluded a capital funds campaign in March of 1964 over-subscribing its goal by 180 per cent and last Sunday underwrote a budget in excess of \$25,000. The congregation expects to erect its main chapel in approximately three years.


