General Telephone To Expand

Expansion and improvement in figures totaling more than \$7 million are planned by the General Telephone Co., in the South Bay, according to Bernard Le-Baron, division manager for the utility. The local division of the company includes El Nido, Palos Verdes, Redondo Beach and Rolling Hills central offices and serves more than 102,000 telephones.

"Major item in the 1965 budget is \$2,200,000 for telephones and associated equip-ment," Le Baron indicated. Other expenditures will be made for outside plant, in-cluding poles, wire and cable, amounting to more than \$2 million while a similar amount will be spent for cen-tral office equipment. Work-ing tools, vehicles, and miscellaneous equipment will toltal almost \$600,000.

The South Bay division gained about 7,000 telephones during the past year and the company expects to add almost 8,000 during 1965.

The total company-wide in The total company-wide investment by General Telephone Co. of California for 1965 will be approximately \$118 million, representing the largest expansion program in the utility's history, according to Parker Sullivan, president.
