Garden Checklist 1. At the top of the list comes post-Christmas care


for living Christmas trees and gift plants. Move living Chirstmas trees out to the deck or terrace. You can keep them in their containers for indoor use again next year. Be sure to keep Christmas plants watered. Azaleas can stand plunging into a sinkful of water occasionally - pot and all - cyclamen should be planted in the ground or set the pot and all into the ground, as soon as its decorative value is no longer needed indoors.

2. This is the time to get bareroot plants. Roses fruit trees, flowering trees, deciduous shrubs and shade trees are all available bareroot now.
