50 Classes Slated in Extension

Almost 50 classes are listed for the extension division at Marymount College for the spring schedule beginning Feb. 1, ranging from art to theology. Art classes include photography, advanced life drawing, modern art history, textiles, oil painting for both beginners and advanced students, and Oriental brush painting. Creative writing, the English novel and literature of the Middle Ages are offered by the English department, while the education department lists psychological foundations and reading and language arts. FRENCH CLASSES include French conversation, Sixteenth Century French, and linguistics and methods, and Spanish classes are Spanish conversation for beginners and advanced students, and linguistics and methods. The Rev. Salvatore M. DiNardo will teach Italian for beginners, and intermediate Italian. OTHER CLASSES are business policy, introduction to journalism, communication arts, League of Nations and the United Nations, elementary and intermediate Russian and social theology. Readers theatre, introduction of speech therapy, introduction to theatre arts, acting fundamentals and survey of theatre arts will be given by the theatre arts and speech department.
