I would like to warn you again not to cut back any frost damaged plants until all danger of further frost is over. You should not water frost damaged plants more than enough to keep them alive until the frost danger is over. When you see the first new growth start later this season and you are sure there will be no more frost— then and only then prune back all the damaged area and start your regular water-ing program. It would be well at that time to add Vita-min Bl solution to the water but no fertilizer. Watch carefully for insects. Snails particularly like these tor pellets will take care of them. If aphis attack the new growth, spray with a mild nicotine spray. Remember, a frost dam-aged plant is like a sick child and muss be treated
