

El Camino Instructor Attends Field Meeting

New perspectives of an ancient subject will be offered students of geology at El Camino College this fall.

Sharing impressions gained through a 23-day field conference held in Nevada this summer will be Miss Joan Baldwin, a member of the ECC instructional staff in the area of natural sciences.

Sponsored by the National Science Foundation and the Mackay School of Mines, University of Nevada, the First Basin and Range Geology Field Conference was launched in Las Vegas.

In the 23-day study, geology professors from 35 universities in the United States, Canada and Jamaica were driven and flown more than 3,000 miles to and over areas of the basin and range province representing some of the most spectacular geology in North America.

PURPOSE OF THE conference was to make available to geology professors new concepts of instruction through onsite experience in one of America's most challenging geographic regions.

Directed by Dr. Joseph Lintz, Jr., professor of geology and paleontology at the Mackay School of Mines, the conference was financed by the National Science Foundation and headed by nationally-known geologists representing both science and industry.

The three-week program included 18 days of field study which took the group to various sections of the State of Nevada. In the field the participating educators were under the leadership of U. S. Geological Survey geologists and others who have specialized in the different areas under study.

Highlighting the conference was a day-long chartered flight over important features of the basin and range province, from Mt. Whitney

in California to the Grand Canyon, Ariz., and the mining districts of northern Nevada.

THE GROUP stayed for different lengths of time in eight Nevada cities and towns. The program was concluded in Reno with a series of lectures at the Mackay School of Mines, University of Nevada.

During their tour, the visiting professors were also able to see some of Nevada's scenic centers, and many modern mining areas and historic ghost towns, including the famous Comstock Lode of Virginia City, Nev., some 20 miles away from the University.

Miss Baldwin, who completed work for the bachelor of arts degree at the University of California at Berkeley, also holds a master's degree in arts from the University of Southern California.

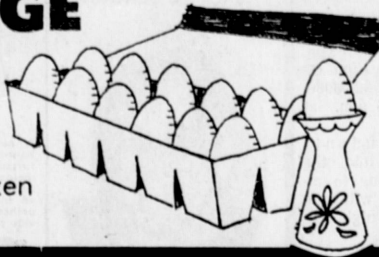

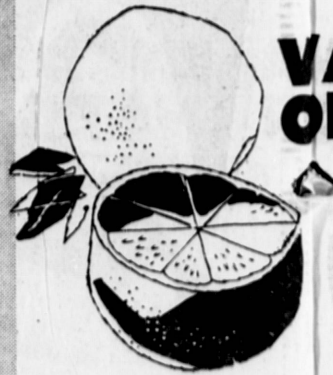
