Resurfacing Of Streets Authorized

A multiple highway improvement—the resurfacing of approximately 175,000 square feet of pavement—has been authorized in this area, reports Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

Streets getting new surfaces include: 213th Street from Dolores to Grace streets, Dolores Street from 213th Street to 345 feet south of Double Street, 222nd Street to Marbella Avenue, and from Avalon Boulevard to Newkirk Avenue, Catskill Avenue from Marbella, Hanson and Newkirk avenues in the vicinity of 222nd Street, and Copeland Street in the vicinity of Marbella Avenue.

Supervisor Hahn points out the proposed project is a part of the county's Road Betterment Program designed to keep the roadway system in top operational condition.
